Jesus Fills us Up by REVEALING THE FATHER, RECLAIMING GOD’S IMAGE IN US & REVERSING THAT WHICH WAS UNDONE

If you really know me, you will know my Father as well. From now on, you do know him and have seen him.” John 14:7

I. Colossians 1:15-17 - Restoration

¹⁵ **The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. ¹⁶ For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. ¹⁷ He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.**

Jesus Reclaims the Undone by RESTORING HIS KINGDOM

“This is how much God loved the world: He gave his Son, his one and only Son. And this is why: so that no one need be destroyed; by believing in him, anyone can have a whole and lasting life. God didn’t go to all the trouble of sending his Son merely to point an accusing finger, telling the world how bad it was. He came to help, to put the world right again. John 3:16-17 MSG

II. Colossians 1:18 - Re-creation

¹⁸ **And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy.**

Jesus Reclaims the Undone by RE-CREATING AND RENEWING ALL THAT IS HIS

*He who was seated on the throne said, "I am making everything new!"
Revelation 21:5a*

III. Colossians 1:19-23 - Reconciliation

¹⁹ For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, ²⁰ and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross. ²¹ Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior. ²² But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation— ²³ if you continue in your faith, established and firm, and do not move from the hope held out in the gospel. This is the gospel that you heard and that has been proclaimed to every creature under heaven, and of which I, Paul, have become a servant.
