¹ So here's what I want you to do, God helping you: <u>Take your everyday</u>, <u>ordinary life—your sleeping</u>, <u>eating</u>, <u>going-to-work</u>, <u>and walking-around life—and place it before God as an offering</u>. Embracing what God does for you is the best thing you can do for him.
