### **The Kingdom Life BREAKS DOWN EVERYTHING WE USE TO PROTECT AND PROP UP OUR SELF-IMAGE building our Confidence in Christ**

#### **I. Jeremiah 2:1-3**

The word of the LORD came to me: <sup>2</sup> “Go and proclaim in the hearing of Jerusalem: “This is what the LORD says: “I remember the devotion of your youth, how as a bride you loved me and followed me through the wilderness, through a land not sown. <sup>3</sup> Israel was holy to the LORD, the firstfruits of his harvest; all who devoured her were held guilty, and disaster overtook them,” declares the LORD.

**True Confidence is found in Christ who provides...**

### **FULFILLMENT, SECURITY, FREEDOM, IDENTITY & INNOCENCE for our lives.**

#### **II. Jeremiah 2:4-13**

<sup>13</sup> “My people have committed two sins: They have forsaken me, the spring of living water, and have dug their own cisterns, broken cisterns that cannot hold water.”

### **When we pursue FULFILLMENT outside of Christ, we end up DRY AND EMPTY**

*On the last and greatest day of the festival, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, “Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink. <sup>38</sup> Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them.” John 7:37-38*

### **III. Jeremiah 2:14-19**

<sup>17</sup> Have you not brought this on yourselves by forsaking the LORD your God when he led you in the way? <sup>18</sup> Now why go to Egypt to drink water from the Nile? And why go to Assyria to drink water from the Euphrates? <sup>19</sup> Your wickedness will punish you; your backsliding will rebuke you.

### **VULNERABLE AND WOUNDED**

<sup>9</sup> Yes, I am the gate. Those who come in through me will be saved. They will come and go freely and will find good pastures. <sup>10</sup> The thief's purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life.

### **IV. Jeremiah 2:20-25**

<sup>25</sup> Do not run until your feet are bare and your throat is dry. But you said, 'It's no use! I love foreign gods, and I must go after them.'

### **SLAVERY AND ADDICTION**

*But the Scriptures declare that we are all prisoners of sin, so we receive God's promise of freedom only by believing in Jesus Christ. Galatians 3:22 NLT*

### **V. Jeremiah 2:26-32**

<sup>27</sup> They say to wood, 'You are my father,' and to stone, 'You gave me birth.' They have turned their backs to me and not their faces; yet when they are in trouble, they say, 'Come and save us!'

**When we pursue IDENTITY outside of Christ, we end up in**

### **INSIGNIFICANCE AND MEANINGLESSNESS**

*And because we are his children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, prompting us to call out, "Abba, Father." Galatians 4:6 NLT*

### **VI. Jeremiah 2:33-37**

<sup>35</sup> you say, 'I am innocent; he is not angry with me.' But I will pass judgment on you because you say, 'I have not sinned.'

**When we assert our INNOCENCE outside of Christ, we end up**

### **under GOD'S JUDGEMENT IN GUILT AND SHAME**

*If we claim we have no sin, we are only fooling ourselves and not living in the truth. <sup>9</sup> But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness. 1 John 1:8–10 NLT*
