# Maturity is shown in the way <u>WE IMITATE GOD BY GIVING</u> <u>AND RECEIVING IN LOVING GENEROSITY</u>

Watch what God does, and then you do it, like children who learn proper behavior from their parents. Mostly what God does is love you. Keep company with him and learn a life of love. Observe how Christ loved us. His love was not cautious but extravagant. He didn't love in order to get something from us but to give everything of himself to us. Love like that. Ephesians 5:1-2 MSG

## I. <u>Philippians 4:10-13</u>

<sup>10</sup> I rejoiced greatly in the Lord that at last you renewed your concern for me. Indeed, you were concerned, but you had no opportunity to show it. <sup>11</sup> I am not saying this because I am in need, for I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. <sup>12</sup> I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. <sup>13</sup> I can do all this through him who gives me strength.

Mature Giving shows <u>CONCERN</u> for people regardless of our personal <u>CIRCUMSTANCES</u>

Mature Receiving demonstrates <u>CONTENTMENT</u> in all <u>CIRCUMSTANCES</u> through Christ, keeping us from becoming MANIPULATIVE AND ENTITLED

Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you." Hebrews 13:5

#### II. Philippians 4:14-20

<sup>14</sup> Yet it was good of you to <u>share in my troubles</u>. <sup>15</sup> Moreover, as you Philippians know, in the early days of your acquaintance with the gospel, when I set out from Macedonia, not one church shared with me in the matter of giving and receiving, except you only; <sup>16</sup> for even when I was in Thessalonica, you sent me aid more than once when I was in need. <sup>17</sup> Not that I desire your gifts; what I desire is that more be credited to your account. <sup>18</sup> I have received full payment and have more than enough. I am amply supplied, now that I have received from Epaphroditus the gifts you sent. They are a fragrant offering, an acceptable sacrifice, pleasing to God. <sup>19</sup> And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus. <sup>20</sup> To our God and Father be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Mature Giving finds a way to <u>CONNECT</u> with someone's trouble and have <u>CONSISTENCY</u> walking with them in their journey.

Mature Receiving recognizes the <u>CONTRIBUTION</u> as a Sacrifice and is seen as a <u>CREDIT</u> to the Giver showing both <u>GRATITUDE AND HONOR</u>

Give, and you will receive. You will be given much. Pressed down, shaken together, and running over, it will spill into your lap. The way you give to others is the way God will give to you." Luke 6:38 NCV

## III. Philippians 4:21-22

<sup>21</sup> Greet all God's people in Christ Jesus. The brothers and sisters who are with me send greetings. <sup>22</sup> All God's people here send you greetings, especially those who belong to Caesar's household. <sup>23</sup> The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen.

## Mature Giving & Receiving declares <u>THE EQUALITY OF ALL</u> WHO RECEIVE GRACE IN CHRIST.

So in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith, <sup>27</sup> for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. <sup>28</sup> There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. Galatians 3:26-28
