As water reflects the face, so one's life reflects the heart. Proverbs 27:19

I. <u>Ephesians 2:10 - NKJV</u>

¹⁰ For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

Reflection <u>MAKES US CONFRONT THE RANDOMNESS OF</u> <u>LIFE</u>

And DRIVES US TO SEEK TRUE PURPOSE
